Wed., June 18 – CHICAGO / EN ROUTE

We depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport this afternoon by scheduled nonstop service of Aer Lingus on the overnight transatlantic flight to Dublin, Ireland. (I)


Thurs., June 19 - DUBLIN / Kilkenny / CORK

As the sun begins to rise on the Irish coast we arrive in Dublin where we'll meet Patrick Foley, our Irish Driver Guide, who will accompany us on vacation. Shortly after leaving the airport we'll stop for a traditional Irish breakfast. Then, we'll be on our way to Kilkenny, a medieval city with a rich heritage in the heart of Ireland's Ancient East. Following an introduction to Kilkenny, we'll set aside time for lunch on your own before we continue our journey south across the fertile farmland and rolling uplands of County Tipperary where we'll stop to view the Rock of Cashel, one of the most spectacular archeological sites in Ireland. Our day comes to an end in the city of Cork. Sitting proudly on an island in the middle of the River Lee, Cork's feelgood buzz surges through its hip coffee shops, vibrant art galleries, off-beat museums and seriously good pubs. (I,B,D)

Fri., June 20 - CORK (Kinsale)

Our day begins with a tour of Cork: its history, its people, colorful culture, wit and special traditions. A Step-on Guide will introduce us to the scents and sounds of the English Market, we'll stroll the busy lanes of the 18th century Huguenot Quarter and take in the magnificent French neo-gothic cathedral. This afternoon we'll visit the seaside town of Kinsale. Considered one of the prettiest small towns in Ireland, Kinsale attracts food lovers from far and wide with its wonderful restaurants and pubs. We'll get to know Kinsale on a relaxed but highly focused food stroll with an engaging and experienced guide. We'll go to places that are off the usual food route where tastings are generous and the people lively. Cork people are enormously proud of their food and quite rightly! (B,L)

Sat., June 21 – CORK (Blarney Castle & Midleton)
This morning we travel to Blarney Castle. Built 600
years ago by one of Ireland's greatest chieftains,
Cormac MacCarthy. We'll climb the steps of the
castle where we'll see, and you'll have an opportunity
to kiss the legendary Stone of Eloquence. Just a
stone's throw away we'll also take time to explore the
Blarney Woolen Mills, the largest emporium of Irish
crafts in the country where you can browse the finely
woven Irish woolen products or relax at one of its
welcoming pubs. This afternoon we're then headed
to Midleton to visit the Jameson Heritage Centre
where the story of Irish Whiskey is explained as we



tour the old distillery introducing us to the mills, maltings and still-houses, each of which produce a different brand of Irish whiskey. (B)

Sun., June 22 – CORK / KILLARNEY

Today we depart Cork and travel to Bantry House, a magnificent mansion surrounded by beautiful gardens overlooking the sea. Built in the mid-18th century, Bantry House is furnished with an eclectic collection of art and furnishings brought from all over Europe by the second Earl of Bantry. The surrounding grounds are impeccably cared for and include a Rose Garden and Italian Garden inspired by the famous Boboli Gardens in Florence, Italy. Afterward, we'll continue north to Molly Gallivan's Cottage & Visitor Centre where we'll have time for shopping and experience a wild Irish Poitin (Whiskey) making demonstration and tasting. Then we'll set our sights on Killarney in County Kerry. Set in the scenic southwest, we'll find some of the most picturesque views in all of Ireland, along with incredible people, food, scenery, and pubs! (B,D)

Mon., June 23 – KILLARNEY (Gap Of Dunloe)

Our day begins at Kate Kearney's Cottage, once home to a local beauty who ran an illegal-drinking house for passing travelers. Today the cottage marks our starting point for a **Jaunting Car Ride** through the famed Gap of Dunloe. The Gap is a four-mile gulch where glaciers have carved a striking mountain pass offering fabulous views of the boulder-strewn gorge, the Purple Mountain and the three Lakes of Killarney. Just as our carriage ride comes to an end, we'll **Cruise Lough Leane** towards Ross Castle, a 15th century tower house and keep that was the ancestral home of the O'Donoghue clan. **(B)**

Tues., June 24 – KILLARNEY (Dingle Peninsula)

Today we explore the Dingle Peninsula, the westernmost part of Ireland that juts out into the Atlantic and is home to some of the most ancient and traditional aspects of Irish culture. We'll begin our day with a visit to the fishing port of Dingle, and then make our way around the Slea Head promontory where we'll see the prehistoric beehive huts that were used as shelter for monks in the early Christian period, and from where there is a spectacular view of the Blasket Islands. From here we'll travel in the shadow of the towering Brandon Mountains and through remote areas of the peninsula to arrive in Kilmalkedar, home to a medieval ecclesiastical Irish Romanesque church with stone carvings. Our last visit of the day will take us to the nearby Gallarus Oratory, one of the few remaining drystone churches of this type to survive intact today. (B)

Wed., June 25 – KILLARNEY / ENNIS

This morning we depart Killarney and travel northwest towards to Tarbet where we'll board a ferry for the 20-minute journey across the Shannon Estuary to Killimer. Then, we set our sights on the majestic Cliffs of Moher. Even when shrouded in sea mist or buffeted by gales, the Cliffs of Moher are a stunning sight as they rise 650 feet from out of the Atlantic. Here, we'll enjoy a visit to the eco-friendly Visitor Centre and Cliffs Exhibition that brings the story of the cliffs to life. Following our visit, we travel inland to the charming town of Ennis, where the narrow winding lanes are particularly characteristic and recall the town's medieval beginnings. As we'll soon find out, steeped in 6,000 years of history the lively town of Ennis is a stronghold of Irish music and culture. (B,D)

Thurs., June 26 – ENNIS (Aran Islands)

Today we travel to the beautiful seaside village of Doolin, a vibrant place full of characters, stories, and experiences - not too mention a dramatic landscape that cannot be easily forgotten. Doolin also marks our departure point for Inishmore, the largest of the three Aran Islands. The islands - the last lands to the west before you reach America - have maintained a culture and heritage of traditional Irish life, and continue to fascinate visitors who make the journey every year. Sit back, relax and enjoy the offshore views on the Doolin Express Ferry to harbour Cill Rónáin. As we'll soon learn, life on the Aran Islands is traced back to 4000 B.C. Ancient Christian and Celtic ruins and neolithic tombs such as the mighty Dun Aonghasa and Na Seacht d'Teampaill are evidence of this. And we won't forget that a visit to the Aran Sweater Market in Kilronan or a craft shop is a must. Inishmore was also the setting for the

movie, "The Banshees of Inisherin." This evening we'll travel to Bunratty where we'll join the Earl of Thomond for **Bunratty Castle Medieval Banquet** at the majestic 15th century castle. And perhaps a pint at Durty Nelly's, the iconic pub just a stone's throw from the castle. **(B,D)**

Fri., June 27 – ENNIS / CHICAGO

As all good things must come to an end, so too does our Southwest Ireland vacation. After breakfast this morning we depart Ennis and travel to Dublin Airport in preparation for our return journey home. No better time to reflect on memories of our vacation to last a lifetime and new friendships made along the way! **(B,I)**
