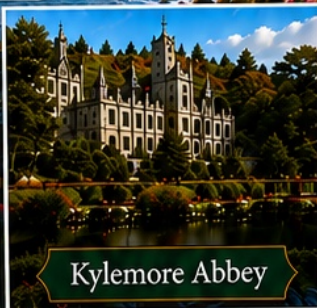

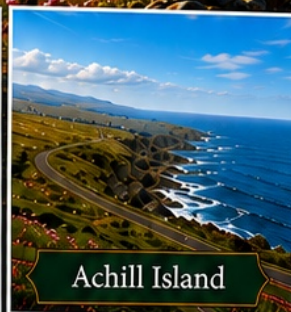

ITINERARY

MONDAY, JUNE 21 – CHICAGO / EN ROUTE

Today we depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport on our non-stop flight to Dublin, Ireland. (I)

TUESDAY, JUNE 22 – DUBLIN / GALWAY

As the sun rises on the Irish coast we arrive in Dublin. We are met by our Irish Driver/Guide who will travel with us throughout our tour. We then begin our drive across Ireland. We make a stop at the Kilbeggan Distillery, where they have been producing Irish whiskey double distilled the old way, to preserve more flavor whilst retaining the classic Irish smoothness since 1797. From Kilbeggan we continue to Galway, the City of Tribes. This evening dinner is included at our hotel. (I,D)

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 23 – GALWAY / WESTPORT

We say farewell to Galway this morning and explore the rugged yet serene Connemara region. A rocky land of broad-backed mountains and pearl like lakes, dotted with herds of sheep. We visit picturesque Kylemore Abbey, a neo-gothic mansion now occupied by Benedictine Nuns. We will then make a stop at Aasleagh Falls. Anyone who wants to make the short hike to see the beautiful falls is in for a treat. We continue to the village of Westport, known as "The Best Place to Live in Ireland." We will enjoy a pub tour of Westport this evening. This evening dinner is included at our hotel. (B,D)

THURSDAY, JUNE 24 – WESTPORT

This morning we travel to Achill Island, home to some of the most stunning scenery on the Wild Atlantic Way. First inhabited 5,000 years ago, Achill Island is Ireland's largest island, offering beautiful views and spectacular beaches. We'll visit the Deserted Village at Slievemore, which consists of the remains of traditional stone cottages and provides a haunting reminder of times past on Achill Island. Achill's dramatic scenery is also the star of the movie, "The Banshees of Inisherin." On our return to Westport we visit Mulranny to enjoy the stunning scenic views of Clew Bay, highlighting the bay's famous **drowned drumlin islands**, the Atlantic Ocean and Croagh Patrick. (B)

FRIDAY, JUNE 25 – WESTPORT

We enjoy a scenic day exploring the dramatic beauty of northwest Ireland. Our first stop is the breathtaking Benbulbin viewpoint, where we'll see Ireland's most iconic tabletop mountains and capture unforgettable photographs. Next we visit the charming seaside village of Strandhill, where there is time to stroll the Atlantic shoreline, browse the shops, or relax at one of the cafes while enjoying lunch on your own. Those wishing to indulge in a uniquely Irish experience may choose an optional visit to the famous Voya Seaweed Baths. If time permits we will also make a stop at the picturesque Glencar Waterfall, celebrated by W.B. Yeats for its tranquil beauty. On our return to Westport a visit The White Hag Brewery, one of Ireland's most acclaimed craft breweries, where we learn about the innovative brewing traditions and sample some of their distinctive creations before returning to our hotel. (B)



SATURDAY, JUNE 26 – WESTPORT

Today's journey showcases some of County Mayo's most spectacular scenery as we travel along the scenic shores of majestic Killary Fjord. We visit the picturesque village of Leenane, nestled at the head of the fjord with time to explore on your own. Next we visit the Killary Sheep Farm, where we experience authentic rural Irish life while enjoying an entertaining working sheep dog demonstration. We also learn about traditional sheep farming and the daily life of an Irish farm family. If time permits our return journey takes us through the hauntingly beautiful Doolough Valley, one of Ireland's most unspoiled landscapes, before returning to Westport. (B)

SUNDAY, JUNE 27 – WESTPORT / ATHLONE

Today we enjoy a scenic drive through the heart of Ireland, traveling across rolling green countryside to the elegant Tullyally Castle Gardens, one of Ireland's finest scenic historic estates. Stroll through the beautifully landscaped gardens where winding pathways, ornamental lakes, woodlands and colorful floral displays create a peaceful setting steeped in history. Our journey continues to the charming riverside town of Athlone, situated on the banks of the majestic River Shannon. After time to explore the town we gather this evening for a delightful group dinner. (B,D)

MONDAY, JUNE 28 – ATHLONE / DUBLIN

This morning we depart Athlone and begin with a visit to the remarkable Clonmacnoise Monastic Site, one of Ireland's most important early Christian settlements. Founded by St. Ciaran in the 6th century, this historic site features ancient cathedral ruins, beautifully carved High Crosses, round towers and centuries of fascinating Irish history. This afternoon we set our sights on the capital city of Dublin. This evening we celebrate with a traditional Irish House Party, featuring a delicious dinner accompanied by lively Irish music, singing, storytelling and warm hospitality for an unforgettable evening. TUESDAY, JUNE 29 – DUBLIN

This morning, enjoy a leisurely walking tour in the heart of Dublin.

We begin with the historic exterior of Trinity College, Ireland's oldest university, before strolling along the lively pedestrian area of Grafton Street, renowned for its boutiques, cafés, and street performers. We continue through the peaceful gardens of St. Stephen's Green, Dublin's beautiful Victorian park and a favorite gathering place for locals and visitors alike. Our visit culminates with a complimentary pint of Guinness as you enjoy panoramic views of Dublin from the spectacular Gravity Bar.
